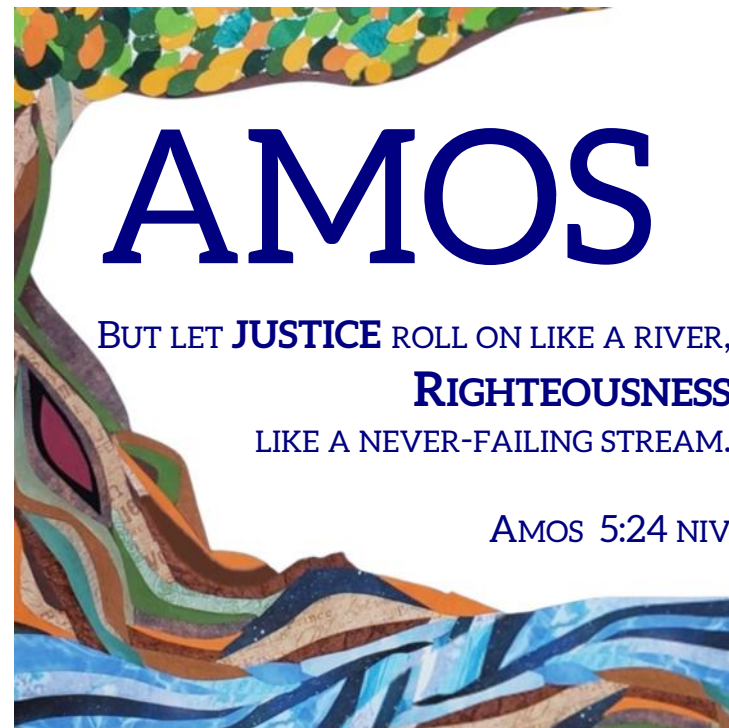
PETITIONS—Pray for:
