- Those healing from injuries or dealing with health issues (Bobi, Jean A., Glenna, Louise, Rozemary, Cindy, Linda MK, others)

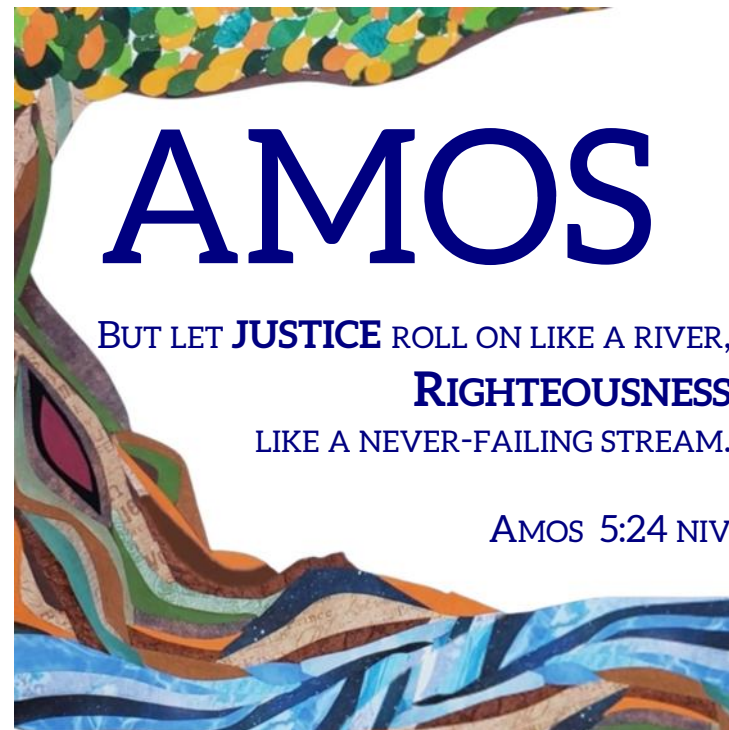
